FEIF Youth Cup is an opportunity for young people from around the FEIF Nations to come together and experience their own tournament with preparations in training then performance. Whilst you will be a part of a GB team – once at Cup, each National team is disbanded and riders placed in to International teams – with these teams you will train and eventually compete during the tournament.



The days of the Cup are normally represented by team training with your horse or in theory lessons, evening fun, a day off and then finishing with days of competition.

Who should apply?

- Any member of IHSGB between 13 17 years of age
- You should have an interest in oval track competition and experience in this
- You must be confident to look after yourself and your horse during the week of Cup (No parents/guardians are allowed access to the Youth Cup facilities – except as spectators during the tournament)
- Please note that each rider will be responsible for costs of participation at Cup.

All applicants will be considered.

You and your horse will be asked to attend some training within the UK prior to selection. There will be a selection process for both rider and horses. If needed, there will be the opportunity to 'hire' a horse for the Cup.
