Numbers are limited but we have two options for accommodation

- We can accommodate up to 3 horse boxes max 3.5T carrying 2 horses each to camp with own tent onsite in field by Peter's home. Shower, toilet, microwave, fridge and freezer facilities are available with running water.
- Alternatively we have two Eco Pods available not far from course site which each have a double bed and two singles in each. Cooking facilities with chemical toilet and shower are in each pod. We will offer 20% discount from normal weekend price of £180 for those wishing to stay – this price allows for a Fri-Mon stay (this price is separate to the show cost.) Description of classes

Tölt

T6 loose rein tölt: riders compete in small groups directed by the speaker, showing slow to medium speed tölt, then return to walk and change rein. Riders then show slow to medium speed tölt, on the long sides holding both reins in one hand clearly showing no rein contact with the horse's mouth.

T7 tölt: riders compete in small groups directed by the speaker, showing slow tölt first, and then change the rein, showing any speed tölt. Riders should indicate on the entry form which rein they wish to start on.

4gait

V5 4 gait: riders compete in small groups directed by the speaker, showing any speed tölt, slow to medium trot, medium walk and slow to medium canter on one rein. Riders should indicate on the entry form which rein they wish to ride on.
