| Ongoing – Regional Reps. The committee feels strongly that a strengthened regional structure is essential to move the Society forward. We also need a clear job description of what is expected from regional reps. One trustee should be the link between the reps and the Board. | <p>6. Regional/other sport activities Are there any regional activities which the sport group can or should support? TiH – need for more specialised judges. Lack of judges is holding back the spread of more TiH. Possibility to encourage some GB coaches or ‘national’ judges to support the development of TiH for the time being. The sport group will contact regional reps to offer advice and support for local organisers to get active. Encourage people to replicate events that are happening elsewhere.</p> | <p>MA</p> |
