<p>1 Sport Squad KC and AN to prepare programme for the season, and see how töltonline might be made use of. Further ideas from everyone in the Sport Group are welcome. Currently very quiet. Emphasis on riders to react to information, provide feedback etc. Currently the focus is education and to send a strong team to the MEM.</p>	KC/AN
<p>2 Töltonline Progress: Announced in recent Newsletter, about to be launched on facebook. Feedback from Freya (and Fi) well worth the entry fee. We will drop V4 and replace it with V6. Add Instructions to the effect that unless otherwise specified riders should show no less than one round, and no more than two rounds of each gait. Kirsty will draft some explanatory notes. At this time töltonline is regarded more as a training tool than a competition. We might add a score board and ranking system at some later stage, possibly winter 2018/19.</p>	KC
<p>3 Online dressage No news from Shona's current initiative. There is still a strong feeling that we should include dressage in töltonline, so we can offer a judged dressage element for Icelandic horses, judged by Icelandic horse judges. This was discussed at some length, AS and LC will consult with Shona and make a proposal for next meeting. Suggestion to change the word dressage to "Icelandic schooling" and to reintroduce the walk – trot, tölt test in one form, or another The FEIF "dressage" classes are called FS1 and FS2.</p>	AS / LC
